Dear Ms. Jadczak:

On September 1, 1992 the licensee requested an amendment to their license (License No. 37-01553-04) in order to identify a physician as an authorized user to perform and supervise teletherapy treatments. During the NRC staff review and evaluation of the physician's qualifications, submitted as part of the licensing action, the staff determined that the physician's qualifications did not meet the NRC requirements established in 10 CFR Part 35.960. On September 22, 1992 the staff also determined that there was no other authorized user at the hospital to supervise teletherapy treatments of patients.

Pursuant to a telephone conversation between you, Ms. Sheila Sferrella, Dr. Joel Swartz, and Dr. Mohamed Shanbaky and Ms. Pamela Henderson of this office on September 24, 1992, it is our understanding that you have taken or will take the following actions which will be completed by the dates specified:

- 1. You have suspended patient teletherapy treatments beginning September 23, 1992, pending your Radiation Safety Committee approval of a qualified visiting teletherapy authorized user in accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR Part 35.27.
- You will submit to this office a license amendment request by October 9, 1992, naming a qualified permanent teletherapy authorized user on your license.
- You will provide supervision as described in 10 CFR Part 35.25 to all individuals involved in teletherapy treatments including any physicians not named on the license as authorized teletherapy users.

Further, we understand that all actions established by this letter will be adhered to and will not be changed unless you receive authorization from the Regional Administrator, NRC Region I.
