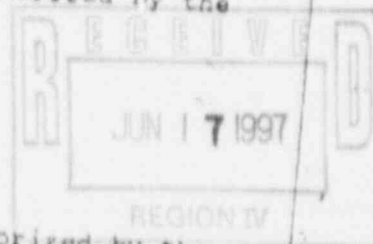
12. Sealed sources containing radioactive material shall not be opened.

14. The licensee shall use a calibrated dose calibrator to assay all radiopharmaceuticals that are received by the licensee in multidose quantities or prepared by the licensee from kits and generators.

15. The licensee shall report any irregularities to the Agency associated with identification, labeling, quality or assay of any radiopharmaceutical received under the authority of this license. A written report shall be submitted to the Agency within 30 days of such an occurrence.

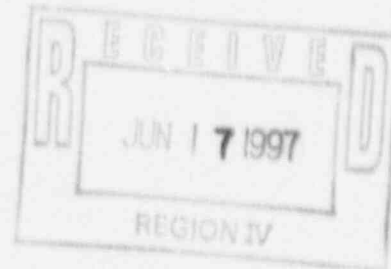

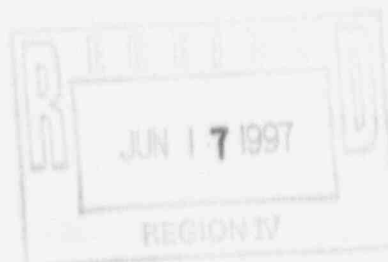
