SUBJECT: ATTACK ON SECURITY GUARD

The licensee reported that on May 24, 1986, at 1:00 a.m., a security guard patrolling the facility was struck on the head by an unidentified assailant using a blunt object. The guard had been investigating a suspicious movement seen inside the restricted area fence and received a concussion as a result of the attack. His assailant escaped. The licensee and local sheriff's department are investigating the incident.
