Instructions for all personnel handling radioactive animals and or contaminated stall contents.

1. When handling these items each person should utilize the principals of time, distance and shielding. When shielding cannot be employed the individual should stay as far away from the source as possible. When these articles must be handled, the task should be completed as quickly as possible.

2. These individuals will be instructed to upon completion of cleaning up a radioactive stall they are to monitor there hands, boots, and clothing for any radioactive material. 3. The radioactive contents will be contained and secured in as small an area as possible.

4. These same contents when possible are to be placed in plastic bags and locked in a limited access area until determined to be at safe levels.

5. The handlers will be provided with a monitoring device on a trial basis to determine if the exposure rates are less than 10 percent of the maximum permissible dose.


