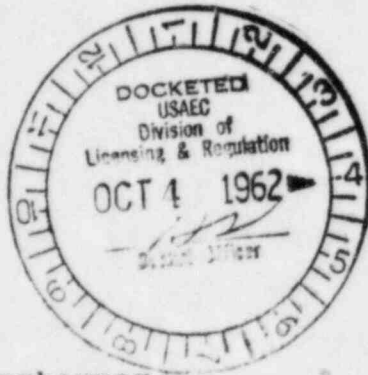

Subject: Source Material License SUA-455, Naturita Concentrator

Dear Mr. Nussbaumer:

We have your letter of September 24, 1962, requesting a work schedule for our Naturita Concentrator operation which we give as follows:

All employees at the Naturita Concentrator, with exception of 3 supervisory employees, are on a 6-day work week schedule. Each employee has one day off per week staggered so that the plant operates on a continuous basis.

The supervisory personnel also has staggered days off but are on a 5-1/2 day work week.

Since the supervisory employees individual exposure is low and to prevent additional complications of the work schedule for the exposure calculations, we request that all employees be deemed to work a 6-day work week.
