This is to confirm our discussion with you on [REDACTED] whereby you decided to decline a personal interview with the NRC Comanche Peak Technical Review Team for the purpose of providing you with feedback on your concerns regarding the construction of this facility. At that time we indicated that our feedback function could be accomplished by any one of three means. These included (1) invitational travel for yourself to Washington with all expenses being paid by the NRC, (2) travel by the TRT to your home or, (3) transmittal of all applicable information to you by letter.
