SUBJECT: License Application for CMI International Corp.

Gentlemen:

Enclosed are two copies of CMI International Corporation's license application for possession, use, storage, distribution, and manufacturing of the beta-backscatter coating measurement devices utilizing byproduct material. The general scope of activities is described in the attached "Scope of License Activities". CMI International will acquire the assests of Magnaflux Sigma and continue the type of activities currently authorized by US NRC license 12-00622-09 and 12-00622-10G. The Magnaflux Sigma Radiation Safety Program and Quality Assurance Program were used in the preparation of the enclosed application in order to accomplish a trouble free transition and to expedite license review and approval. The Magnaflux Sigma and CMI International programs and procedures are essentially the same. CMI International is comprised of former Magnaflux management that were involved in the Magnaflux GM-1 program.

Magnaflux Sigma will terminate their 12-00622-09 and 12-00622-10G license after CMI International's license application is approved. CMI International will then start operation in the same laboratory as previously operated by Magnaflux Sigma. When the laboratory is completed at 2301 Arthur Avenue, Elk Grove Village, the operations will then move to that address and the CMI International activities at RECEIVED 7300 W. Lawrence Avenue will be terminated.

Apparently a new safety analysis of the CMI International 191985 GM-1 device is not necessary. The CMI International and Magnaflux Sigma GM-1 device are identical, manufactured to the same specifications and in accordance with essential GON III the same Quality Assurance program. I have discussed this with Mr. Steve Baggett (device registration) to familiarize him with this transition and to confirm that our actions and assumptions are correct.
