## P R O C E E D I N G S

CHAIRMAN ZECH: Good afternoon, ladies and gentlemen. This is an affirmation session on a proposed order dealing with the late petition to intervene by the Quivira Mining Company, Homestake Mining Company and United Nuclear Corporation in the matter of American Nuclear Corporation.

Before the Secretary asks for our votes on this matter, I would like to ask him to read us through this item on the agenda.

SECRETARY CHILK: Mr. Chairman, I wonder if I could ask the Commission to vote to hold this on less than one week's before we start.

[Chorus of ayes.]

SECRETARY CHILK: The item is SECY-86-186, a Request to Intervene in the Matter of the American Nuclear Corporation in docket number 40-4492.

In this paper the Commission is being asked to act on a late request filed on June 19, 1986 and amended on June 23, 1986 by the Quivira Mining Company to intervene in the matter of the American Nuclear Corporation, a proceeding occasioned by NRC enforcement orders to 11 millers amending their licenses to implement recent environmental regulations.

Chairman Zech, Commissioners Roberts and Asselstine have approved the order which denies Quivira's petition to intervene. Commissioner Bernthal disapproves and indicated

that he would have granted an eight-day extension to Quivira.

Would you please affirm your votes?

[Chorus of ayes.]

SECRETARY CHILK: That completes the affirmation.

CHAIRMAN ZECH: All right. If we have nothing more to come before the Commission, the order is approved and the Commission stands adjourned.
