

Dear Dr. Piccone:

Waterbury Hospital (Waterbury, Connecticut) recently applied for and received an amendment to its material license (#06-02406-01) which authorized the use of a Gadolinium-153 source in conjunction with a dual photon absorptiometry unit. At the time of our amendment request, we had not made a decision as to which of the manufacturers units would be purchased. Subsequent to our amendment's approval, it was decided that the Norland 2600 unit would be purchased. Our amendment specified that the Norland unit was certified only for a Gulf Nuclear Model GD-1 source. Norland has notified us that they have obtained NRC approval for sources other than the Gulf Nuclear source and have designated these sources as "The Norland Gadolinium Series". We request that Item 7J of our materials license be amended to read, "Sealed Source - Norland Gadolinium Series".
