SUBJECT: EXPIRED LICENSE, CONCORD WATCH COMPANY,
NEW YORK, NEW YORK

On October 28, 1985 Region I received a letter with attachments dated September 24, 1985 from the licensee stating that they have decided not to renew License Nos. 31-10569-01E and 12-12687-01E. License No. 31-10569-01E had expired on October 31, 1984.

The licensee stated that they had not imported or sold any time pieces containing tritium nor have they stored any for the past two years.

Based on a review of the information supplied by the licensee and a review of the type and form of material authorized by the license, a close out survey by the licensee is required. A survey dated June 10, 1985 conducted by NDL Organization, Inc. was received with letter dated September 24, 1985 and demonstrates that the facility meets the "Guidelines for Release of Facilities...". A close out survey by Region I is not required.

Based on the above information, we recommend that License No. 31-10569-01E be retired. Please notify us when it is status "4" so we can remove it from our active shelves.
