Dear Mr. Bassett:

This is in response to your letter dated May 6, 1986, in which you requested, pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), copies of the Office of Investigations' report (Case No. 1-84-014) regarding harassment of quality assurance auditors at Nine Mile Point Unit 2 and the transcript of your testimony. This confirms the information conveyed during your telephone conversation with Ms. Linda Robinson on June 25, 1986, in which you inquired about the status of your request.

Copies of the report and accompanying exhibits have been made available for public inspection and copying at the NRC Public Document Room (PDR) in Washington, DC 20555, in the PDR docket file for the Nine Mile Point plant. Enclosed is a copy of the notice that provides procedures and charges for obtaining copies of records from the PDR in order that you may obtain copies of the report and the transcript of your testimony (exhibit 87) and any other exhibits in which you may be interested, such as your prepared statement (exhibit 88). Copies of the report and accompanying exhibits are also being made available at the NRC's Local Public Document Room for the Nine Mile Point plant, which is located at the following address.

During your conversation with Ms. Robinson, you expressed an interest in appealing the deletion of certain information in the requested records. At that time, she informed you that the NRC would provide any personal information about you which was deleted from the requested records if you in fact want such information following your review of the requested records. With regard to the remaining portions of the requested records which have been withheld from public disclosure pursuant to Exemptions (6), (7)(C), and (7)(D) of the FOIA (5 U.S.C. 552(b)(6), (7)(C), and (7)(D)) and 10 CFR (5)(a)(6), (7)(C), and (7)(D) of the Commission's regulations, the denial

may be appealed to the Secretary of the Commission within 30 days from the receipt of this letter. Any such appeal must be in writing, addressed to the Secretary of the Commission, U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Washington, DC 20555, and should clearly state on the envelope and in the letter that it is an "Appeal from an Initial FOIA Decision." We note in this regard that there is a pending lawsuit, Ryan v. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, D.D.C. No. 86-1553, regarding the release of the OI report and exhibits.
