

Pursuant to 10CFR 50.54(p) please find attached five (5) copies of Revision 8, to the Oconee Safeguards Contingency Plan. Revision 8 was generally developed to address organizational changes, several notification and definition deletions, condensation of events and clarify the interactions between the Security Shift Supervisor and the Operations Shift Supervisor. Specific plan changes are addressed in the attachment. Revision 8 does not decrease the effectiveness of the Oconee Nuclear Station Safeguards Contingency Plan.
