

The following commitments are being made by this letter:

- All shift Operations personnel will receive training on this event by 051598 including proper interpretation of the term "valid".
- An off-site evaluation of the binding of the EDG air start motor will be conducted by 093098.
- System Materials Engineering will evaluate the affect of the tape on the performance of the air start solenoid by 033198.
- The Maintenance Work Execution Procedure will be revised by 022798 to
 ensure the procedure comprehensively prohibits such activities as placing and
 removing relay covers without proper authorization.
- Maintenance Continuing and Initial Training will be revised by 051598 to include the above expectation.
- Logic Test procedures will be revised by 032798 to add and sequence steps such that inadvertent actuations are prevented.

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 The operability issues associated with the Unit 1 EDG and the component evaluations identified in items 2 and 3 will be reported in a supplement to this LER by 103198.
