Dear Mr. Subalusky:

On October 31, 1997, the NRC completed an inspection at your LaSalle facility. The enclosed report presents the results of that inspection.

During this 6-week inspection, your conduct of activities at the LaSalle facility was generally characterized as safe and in accordance with plant procedures. Your immediate corrective actions to address equipment failures were appropriate, and maintenance and surveillance activities were performed acceptably. A particular performence strength noted during this inspection was your effective use of lessons learned from previous activities and events in effecting improvements in maintenance and cold weather preparations.

Based on the results of this inspection, the NRC has determined that one violation of NRC requirements occurred. The violation involved the failure to perform an adequate surveillance test on the emergency diesel generators. However, the NRC is exercising enforcement discretion and not issuing a Notice of Violation because the criteria specified in Section VII.B.2, "Violations Identified During Extended Shutdowns or Work Stoppages," of the NRC Enforcement Policy are satisfied. Specifically, the violation is based upon your activities prior to the events leading to your decision in December 1996 to enter into an extended shutdown to address longstanding performance issues. The violation would not have been categorized at Severity Level II, the violation was not willful, and enforcement action was not considered necessary to achieve remedial action. In addition, actions specified in Confirmatory Action Letter RIII-96-008B effectively prevent you from restarting LaSalle County Station without implicit NRC approval.
