Dear Sir:

Florida Power Corporation's (FPC) July 31, 1984 letter to Mr. Darrell G. Eisenhut (3F0784-21) provided updated responses to Generic Letter 83-28 (Salem ATWS). Our responses to the subject items contained commitments to complete documentation reviews required by the Generic Letter not later than December 31, 1985 and to complete revision of existing plant procedures or preparation of any new procedures identified as a result of our review by March 1, 1986. FPC's letter to the NRC, dated February 25, 1986, on Generic Letter 83-28 should have also included the subject items. This letter extends those commitments to Items 3.2.1 and 3.2.2.

The commitment for review of the documentation for all items was met on December 22, 1985.

Because of the greater than expected procedure modifications identified, FPC is revising the second commitment for Items 3.2.1 and 3.2.2 as follows:

1. Those procedures required on a routine basis (Operations Procedures and Surveillance Procedures) will be revised on or before July 31, 1986.
2. Preventative Maintenance Procedures, Maintenance Procedures, and Fueling Procedures will be revised by December 31, 1986.

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
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3. New procedures as identified during the documentation review will be developed as needed in accordance with FSAR Section 1.7.1.5 and Regulatory Guide 1.33 as clarified in FSAR Table 1-3.
