SUBJECT: NRC INSPLCTION REPORT NO. 50-456/97019(DRP); 50-457/97019(DRP) AND NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Dear Mr. Tulon:

On December 15, 1997, the NRC completed an inspection at your Braidwood Units 1 and 2 reactor facilities. The enclosed report presents the results of that inspection. During the 6-week period covered by this inspection, your conduct of activities was generally characterized by safety-conscious operations, sound engineering and maintenance practices, and careful radiological work controls. Operating crews performing the startup from the Unit 2 refueling outage demonstrated excellent human performance when challenged by equipment failures. Additionally, inspectors reviewed three safety-related modifications that were installed during the Unit 2 refueling outage and found that the modifications were processed in accordance with the appropriate procedures, were properly documented, and received proper safety evaluations. How over, we are concerned about the failure of station personnel to identify loose materials in the Unit 2 containment that resulted in a violation. The inspectors found two exartines where the acceptance criteria of the surveillance test procedure were not met following notification by station personnel that the containment loose debris inspection was complete.

The violation is cited in the enclosed Notice of Violation (Notice) and the circumstances surrounding the violation are described in detail in the enclosed report. Please note that you are required to respond to this letter and should follow the instructions specified in the enclosed Notice when preparing your response. Your response should not only detail the actions to be taken for the specific issues identified, but should also be broadly focused on what actions you plan or have taken to ensure that your corrective actions process is effective. The NRC will use your response, in part, to determine whether further enforcement action is necessary to ensure compliance with regulatory requirements.
