To Whom It May Concern:

Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA, 5 U.S.C. 522) and the Federal Privacy Act (5 U.S.C. 522a), I, Blaine P. Thompson, Complainant in the following matter, hereby request copies of any and all NRC records and information, including but not limited to notes, letters, memoranda, drafts, minutes, diaries, logs, calendars, tapes, transcripts, summaries, interview reports, procedures, instructions, drawings, charts, graphs, maps, photographs, files, agreements, handwritten notes, studies, data sheets, printouts, notebooks, books, telephone messages, interim and/or final reports, investigative files, and any and all other records relevant to and/or generated in connection with the following listed items:


- Item 1. NRC and/or ANPP investigation and findings of ANPP Security Officer, ¹ allegations of assault with deadly weapon and forei¹able rape by Officer,
- Item 2. All above copy requirements and specifically, copies of tape recordings made concerning Arizona Republic Reporter, John Staggs' telephone call to NRC officials on February 25, 1986 regarding Staggs' inquiries as to the NRC Exit Briefing discrepancies and related remarks of February 14, 1986 to ANPP officials.
- Item 3. NRC inspection report and findings of non-compliance concerning NRC inspection of ANPP Security System and safeguards program on February 11, 1986 through February 14, 1986.

For any documents or portion that you deny due to a specific FOIA exemption, please provide an index itemizing and describing the documents or portions of documents withheld. The index should provide a detailed justification of your grounds for claiming such exemption, explaining why each exemption is relevant to the document or portion of the document withheld. This index is required under Vaughn v. Rosen (I), 484 F. 2d 820 (1973).

I request that fees be waived.

I hope to hear from you as soon as possible within the maximum 10 days the law stipulates.
