Enclosed is Licensee Event Report (LER) 98-004, Revision 00, for Quad Cities Nuclear Power Station.

This report is submitted in accordance with the requirements of the Code of Federal Regulations, Title 10, Part 50.73(a)(2)(vii)B. The licensee shall report any single cause of inoperable independent train or channel in a single system designed to remove residual heat.

The following commitments are being made by this letter:

1. Provide training to Operations and Engineering personnel on Technical Specification 3.8.F by 100198.
2. Revise QCTS 0750-01, "Safety Related Snubber Visual Inspection" by 100198 to clarify the requirement to perform the evaluation on inoperability and include required notifications on snubber operability per Technical Specification 3.8.F.
3. Revise QCTS 0750-05 "Snubber Functional Testing Using API/Barker STB 200 Test Bench" by 100198 to include required notifications on snubber operability per Technical Specification 3.8.F.

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
