APPLICATION FOR AMENDMENT TO OPERATING LICENSE

Pursuant to Section 50.90 of the regulations of the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (the "Commission"), Duquesne Light Company ("DLC"), holder of Operating License No. DPR-66, hereby requests that the Technical Specifications set forth in Appendix A to that license be amended to revise Design Feature Section 5.3.1 by removing the fuel rod weight Limitation, the statement following which limits the initial core maximum enrichment and a statement has been incorporated to allow the use of reconstituted fuel assemblies.

The proposed technical specification change is set forth in Attachment A to this Application. A No Significant Hazard Consideration is set forth in Attachment B. Based on the guidance provided by the Commission, the proposed changes have been determined to involve no significant hazards consideration in accordance with 10 CFR 50.92.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests that Appendix A to Operating License No. DPR-66 be amended in the form attached hereto as Attachment A.
