Dear Ms. Dedik :

In reference to your letter of 22 January 1998, I hereby assure you that the Government of the Republic of Korea confirms the following particulars on the international transfer 85,224 kilograms low-enriched uranium for use by the Korea Electric Power Corporation in Kori Units 2 and 4 and Younggwang Units 3 and 4 (export license No. XSNM 03021) :

(a) The transfer of the material will be subject to all terms and conditions of the Agreement for Cooperation Concerning the Civil Uses of Atomic Energy between the Government of the Republic of Korea and the Government of the United States, as amended, which entered into force on March 19, 1973;

(b) The Korea Electric Power Corporation, the ultimate consignee, as identified on the application, is authorized by the Government of the Republic of Korea to receive and possess the material.
