While it is reasonable to assume that many of the rulings concerning the contentions accepted for litigation will be appealed the fact that the version of the New Hampshire Radiological Response Plan (NHRERP) now in litigation is not the operative one and that an amended NHRERP (Revision 2) is forthcoming may render moot certain contentions previously ruled on. The Town of Kensington is concerned that the time and expense required to appeal these contentions will create a burdensome and, indeed, unnecessary workload if Revision 2 renders the contentions irrelevant.
