Dear Mr. Anthony:

This is in response to your petition of March 5, 1986 as supplemented on June 19 and July 7, 1986 requesting that the Nuclear Regulatory Commission take certain actions associated with the usage of cooling water from the Schuylkill River by the Philadelphia Electric Company (PECo) for its Limerick Generating Station, Unit 1. Principally, you requested that the Commission suspend the facility operating license on the basis that PECo had not complied with certain environmental license conditions imposed by the NRC. For the reasons set forth in the enclosed Director's Decision under 10 CFR 2.206, DD-86-14, your request is denied.

A copy of the Decision will be filed with the Secretary of the Commission for its review in accordance with 10 CFR 2.206(c) of the Commission's regulations. As provided by this regulation, the Decision will constitute the final action of the Commission twenty-five days after the date of issuance of the Decision unless the Commission, on its own motion, institutes a review of the Decision within that time. I have also enclosed for your information a copy of the notice that is being filed with the Office of the Federal Register.
