Dear Judge Chilk;

I Barbara Synar, would like to have some input in Kerr-McGee neuclear plant hearing.

My family and I live one-half miles east of Warner, Okla. and feel that Kerr-McGee has contaminated our surrounding areas. They now are negotiating to buy Monsanto Ranch which is aprox. nine thousand acres, which will surround the town of Warner, Oklahoma.

Kerr McGee, said this will be used for their raffinate Fluoride sludge farm. This contains top water sludge, which is 7.7 times higher than allowed concentration. This is not an isolated area.

In 1982, Kerr-McGee began spraying their treated waste fertilizer on land which they bought. This consist of one thousand five hundred acres south of Warner, in Muskogee County. We feel this is a great hazard of contamination, and I can't see all of this good land go to waste.

The town of Warner had petitions of aprox. 2,000 signatures, that were sent to Congressman Mike Synar, Don Nickles, N.R.C., and Kerr-McGee. These petitions were never considered, that the town of Warner did not want their raffinate, injection wells, or any other form of waste.

I feel that this will devaluate our property, homes, water, and our health. I personally would like to see Kerr-McGee closed, If for no other reasons than violations.

- 1. There is no adquate warning system for all surrounding areas.
- 2. Opening holding ponds to run off sludge just where ever.
- 3. Inexperienced training.
- 4. Lack of adquate help in guarding plant.
- 5. Going against N.R.C. regulations.
- 6. Kerr-McGee has no adquate fire protection.
- 7. Robert S. Kerr is on the water resource board.
- 8. To stop burying of contaminated waste.
- 9. Past operations in other states.



We are living in an environment with no security from Kerr-McGee. We the people do not seem to have a say in what kind of contamination Kerr-McGee wants us to have, after all this is not the U.S.S.R. is it?

These were just a portion of violations with Kerr-McGee, and their operations are very sloppy.

I hope that you will give this hearing some deep thought, and realize what danger we are in. It was a blessing that their, were not more lives taken in the Kerr-McGee accident January 4, 1986.

We the people of the surrounding areas, hope we will not have to pay at the expence of the government and politicians!!
