On September 30, 1988 the Commission issued a temporary exemption from the schedular requirements of the property insurance rule effective October 4, 1988 (10 CFR 50.54(w)(5)(i)) for the Fort Calhoun Station, Unit 1. The first page of the exemption sent to you contained a typographical error. The first sentence of the exemption should read as follows: "Omaha Public Power District (the licensee) is the holder of Facility Operating License No. DPR-40. which authorizes operation of the Fort Calhoun Station, Unit 1." The exemption published in the Federal Register on October 12, 1988 (53 FR 39865) did not contain an error so a correction notice is not required.
