This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. E. W. K. Lee of this office on October 23, 1978, of activities at La Salle County Nuclear Station, Unit 2, authorized by NRC Construction Permit No. CPPR-100 and to the discussion of our findings with Mr. B. Rose and others of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

The enclosed copy of our inspection report identifies areas examined during the inspection. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of a selective examination of procedures and representative records, observations, and interviews with personnel.


