SEQUOYAH NUCLEAR PLANT - ADDITIONAL INFORMATION REGARDING STEAM GENERATOR TUBE STRESS RELIEF - U-BEND HEAT TREATMENT

As agreed in the January 2, 1987 meeting with you and other NRC representatives, enclosed is additional information regarding the steam generator tute stress relief (U-bend heat treatment) being performed at Sequoyah Muclear Plant units 1 and 2.
