If any of these experiments have been "written up" in the form of a paper or report, such a document would be a sufficient response to this request. However, if papers or reports have not been prepared, we would request copies of whatever laboratory These experiments were disclosed in early November, and presumably were carried out within the last few months. The Committee to Bridge the Gap is a non-profit research organization which is reviewing the reassessment of nuclear accident source terms in the public interest. We have been invited to present our findings in testimony before the Nuclear Regulatory Commission. The requested documents will be used in our review of NUREG-0956, the NRC's report on source terms which was recently issued for public comment. Results of our research will be provided without charge to the NRC, the Congress, and to other interested parties. We therefore request a fee waiver on search and copying costs. Thank you.
