In answer to your letter of May 2, 1986 concerning NRC Byproduct Material License No. 34-01260-09 and 34-01260-10 I offer the following:

1. Bioassay of employees routinely using unsealed Licensed Material:

(a) A letter will be sent to each licensed individual using unsealed sources indicating that either a urine sample be provided at specified times or a legitimate reason be given as to why not or a sample be provided and delivered to Environmental Health and Safety within a certain time frame.

2. Laboratory Monthly Surveys

A computer program will be developed for scheduling laboratory surveys. This program should help eliminate this problem.

3. ACEL Gamma cell 200 irradiator.


The source is not being used and will be surveyed twice a year. This will also be included in the computer program.
