Dear Chairman Palladino:

I am concerned about the improper action of certain states and cities in attempting to use procedural non-cooperation tactics to block the start-up of nuclear power generating plants. This type of harassment tactic adds greatly to the expense of building such plants, resulting in major additional service cost to energy consumers and loss of profits to stockholders.

Procedural harassment tactics involving refusal to cooperate in the development and implementation of emergency evacuation plans should not be tolerated by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission. There cannot be any justification for allowing local harassment groups to block or delay Federal approval of properly constructed nuclear power plants.

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission should adopt rules without delay to allow immediate start-up of completed nuclear power generating plants.

Please include this request in the record of public hearings being held concerning this matter.
