Dear Mr. Whitten:

Halliburton Company, Dallas, Texas recently purchased
GEO Vann, Inc. which resulted in a name change, activity changes
related to radioactive materials, and personnel changes.

It is requested that Radioactive Material License
42-19764-01 be terminated and Vann Systems, a Halliburton
Company, be brought into and under the umbrella of the
Halliburton Company license number 35-0052-02 along with
Halliburton Services and Otis Engineering.

Vann Systems will assume some of the field service work
previously handled by Halliburton Services which involves the use
of radioactive materials for tracer studies in downhole oil and
gas well operations.

The work at present is so insignificant that the training
for Assistant Radiation Safety Officers for Vann Systems will not
be initiated. However, when the economy permits both Otis
Engineering and Vann Systems will be included in the extensive
training programs. At present all other training and licensing
conditions apply.


