This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by Mr. D. R. Gibbons of this office on June 12, 1986, of activities authorized by NRC Byproduct Material License No. 24-19850-01 and to the discussion of our findings with you at the conclusion of the inspection.


During this inspection, certain of your activities appeared to be in violation of NRC requirements, as specified in the enclosed Notice. A written response is required.




