The review of the Clinton Power Station (CPS) Draft Low Power Operating License (NPF-55) that was transmitted in NRC letter dated June 18, 1986, has been completed by Illinois Power (IP). The following are IP's comments on the draft operating license:

Item (11)D., Page 6:

In Illinois Power letter to the NRC (U-600552), IP requested a deferral of the Traversing Incore Probe System preoperational testing until "prior to exceeding 5% of rated reactor power" and not "prior to reactor heatup" as stated in item (b).

This change was agreed to in a June 23, 1986 discussion with Mr. B. L. Siegel and Mr. R. Becker of NRR.
