Subject: MAIN TRANSFORMER FIRE - MEDIA INTEREST

At 6:32 p.m. on May 18, 1999, a fire occurred at the Pilgrim Station in the main electrical transformer. At the time of the event, the unit was in a refueling outage and the main transformer was electrically isolated, with the transformer oil drained to support maintenance and testing activities. A post-maintenance test was in progress for a component (bushing) that had been replaced during the outage. Shortly after the fire was discovered, the licensee requested off-site firefighting assistance. An Unusual Event was declared at 6:52 p.m. based on the request for this assistance. The fire was characterized as "smoldering with no visible flames.'

Carbon dioxide and a small amount of water was used to suppress the fire. The fire was extinguished at 8:21 p.m., and the Unusual Event was terminated at 9:25 p.m.

The fire had no adverse effect on the plant other than immediate damage to the transformer. Except for a planned outage of the "A" emergency diesel generator and its associated vital bus, the plant's on-site and off-site vital electrical equipment remained available throughout the event. The licensee's initial damage assessment revealed that a bushing and current transformer electrical lead within the main transformer were damaged. The cause of the fire is under investigation by the licensee. One minor injury occurred to a fire brigade member as a result of static discharge during use of a carbon dioxide extinguisher. The individual was transported to a hospital and subsequently released.

The resident inspector responded to the site upon notification of the event.

The licensee issued a Press Release on May 19, 1999.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts has been notified of the event.

Region I received initial notification of the occurrence by telephone call from Eric Olson at 7:13 p.m., on May 18, 1999. The information presented in this PN has been discussed with the licensee and is current as of 11:00 a.m., May 19, 1999.

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
