
Renewal of License No. SNM-142

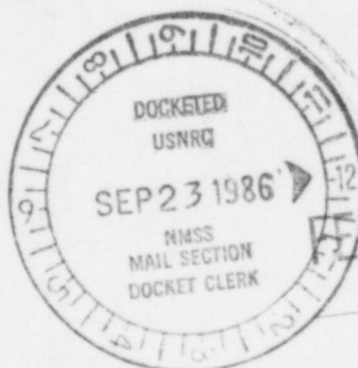
We request that the license be renewed for the maximum period of time permissible under Commission procedures.
