Dear Ms. Garde:

This is in further response to your letter dated January 21, 1985, in which you requested, pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), records related to the NRC Comanche Peak Task Force established in March 1984.

We are now placing a box of allegation tracking system records, which are described on the enclosed Appendix R, in the NRC Public Document Room (PDR) in file FOIA-85-59 under your name.

Portions of the records identified at numbers 224, 226 through 258, and 274 contain information that is being withheld from public disclosure pursuant to Exemption (5) of the FOIA (5 U.S.C. 552(b)(5)) and 10 CFR 9.5(a)(5) of the Commission's regulations. The withheld portions contain the advice, opinions, and recommendations of the staff concerning potential violations. The nonexempt portions of these records are being placed in PDR file FOIA-85-59 under your name.

Pursuant to CFR 9.9 of the Commission's regulations, it has been determined that the information withheld is exempt from production or disclosure and that its production or disclosure is contrary to the public interest. The persons responsible for this denial are the undersigned and Mr. Harold R. Denton, Director, Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation.

This denial may be appealed to the Executive Director for Operations within 30 days from the receipt of this letter. Any such appeal must be in writing, addressed to the Executive Director for Operations, U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Washington, DC 20555, and should clearly state on the envelope and in the letter that it is an "Appeal from an Initial FOIA Decision."

The deleted information consists of names and other identifying information concerning allegers, interviewees, and other individuals.

The events surrounding this incident were reported under Report of Inquiry No. Q4-84-014.

The CPSES ASLB has already ruled on the (NA prenotification issue. No further investigation is anticipated.
