TELEPHONE CONVERSATION RECORD

Party Called: A-36

11/7/84 8:50PM

I called A-36 and explained the purposes of the TRT close-out interviews with individuals who had expressed concerns about Comanche Peak. We set up an interview for 6:20PM on 11/14/84 at [REDACTED] then summarized his concerns, as listed on the sheet provided by the TPT group leader which are in the mechanical/piping area. He said that he is strictly a coatings guy and never made any allegations in the mechanical/piping area. I asked him to describe his coatings concerns. He said that he had talked to NRC/OI in 1982 regarding the unfair termination of A-31 and A-32. [REDACTED] I told him that I would check with OI re the status of this concern and would get back to him the next day. I checked the allegation listing on [REDACTED] and discovered that A-36 has one allegation: AQQ-26 (defects found on a Unit 1 Curtainment plate not reported). All other mechanical/piping allegations apparently have been identified erroneously by the group leader to be linked with A-36.
