The STP Nuclear Operating Company (STPNOC) submits the ached errata pages for the proprietary (WCAP-13698, Rev. 2, Addendum 1) and nonproprietary (WCAP-13699, Rev. 2, Addendum 1) versions of "Laser Welded Sleeves for 3/4 Inch Diameter Tube Feedring Type and Westinghouse Preheater Steam Generators Generic Sleeving Report".

In Reference 1 above, STPNOC provided information to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) regarding reason "(g)" for withholding proprietary information from public disclosure as noted in WCAPs-13698 and -13699. In Reference 2 above, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission responded to Westinghouse that the information in the subject WCAP reports sought to be withheld contains proprietary commercial information and should be exempt from mandatory public disclosure, with the exception of the material indicated by reason "(g)".

Westinghouse has reclassified the information associated with reason "(g)" as nonproprietary. The information is included in the steam generator discussion in a nuclear plant's Final Safety Analysis Report; consequently, the attached errata pages are provided for inclusion into WCAP-13698 and WCAP-13699.
