At approximately 11:30 am on 11/12/84 (Veteran's Day), I received a phone call at home through the NRC operator. The caller identified himself as of Comanche Peak. The caller identified himself as at the Comanche Peak site. I have met with the Brown & Root manager discuss TUGCO personnel exit interviews, and recognized his voice.

the TRT had tried to contact for interview and that had gone to him since he had not been able to return the phone calls. -

that there was an opening at 7:30 pm on 11/15/84 at the Granbury Inn Conference Room. The response was given to him in good faith since he was representing TUGCO management when he called me. The said that the TUGCO attorney. He said no, it would be the attorney. I asked if he meant the TUGCO attorney. He said no, it would be the attorney. I asked if he meant contacted. He said that "they would come to us anyway. ... we are only trying to help..." I told him that it would be the individuals' choice to report the TRT contacts to the utility management, but as a general policy, we do not disclose such information to the utility management.

Knowing that works the day shift, I called him up at 10:30 pm EST on the same day. I asked to verify that what the same mad told me was indeed and told him about the TRT's contacts with him, but he denied any TUGCO policy or procedure requiring him to do so. I asked him why he thought

1/ 7:05 p.m. EST on 11/8/84 and was told by that he was at home but would call me back in 15 minutes. I gave him the NRC operator's in the number and asked him to call back collect. He never returned my calls.


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it was necessary to bring an attorney, he did not answer. He said that TRT calls him in the evenings "during his free time". I said that this is done to protect the individual's identity. I asked him if he would prefer to be contacted or interviewed onsite, he said no. I told him someone from TRT would call him on 11/13 or 11/14 at 6:30 pm CST to confirm the interview.

This appears to be a case of the utility management attempting to interfere with the TRT ongoing inspections/investigations of allegations. I intend to revise the TRT procedure to address this issue. Please advise.
