PORTSMOUTH GASEOUS DIFFUSION PLANT - DOCKET NO. 70-7002 - DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY APPROVAL OF A CHANGE TO COMPLIANCE PLAN ISSUE 23R

On May 12, 1999, the Department of Energy (DOE) received a request from the United States Enrichment Corporation to modify the DOE-approved proposed Portsmouth Gaseous Diffusion Plant (PORTS) Compliance Plan Issue 23R, Plant Changes and Configuration Management (Reopened), transmitted May 10, 1999. The request from the PORTS Plant Operations Review Committee asked for wording to clarify when a Nuclear Criticality Safety review is required for plant change requests.

DOE approves the requested change. On page 3 of Issue 23R, in the Justification for Continued Operation, paragraph 2, Design Requirements, change the second sentence to read:

"All requests for engineering services involving plant changes are reviewed and approved by the Change Control Board (CCB) which includes criticality safety expertise, as required."
