Assistance with Seabrook Activities

This is to request your assistance concerning the review of the Seabrook Plan for Massachusetts Communities (SPMC) recently submitted by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission for review by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). Although the specifics of the review process have not been finalized, I must ask your help in securing someone outside FEMA Region I to manage the project of . reviewing the SPMC, including subsequent testimony in any related Atomic Safety and Licensim Board Hearings.

The FEMA Region I workload, as shown in the attached Technological Hazards Work Plan, includes among other things the Yankee Powe Nuclear Power Plant Exercise in April, 1988, the Haddam Neck Nuclear Power Plant Exercise, and the review of the revised plans and an exercise for the Pilgrim Nuclear Power Plant. Unfortunately, these exercises and the many other items in the Work Plan are such that existing resources would not be able to perform the SPMC review in acceptable time without an unacceptable impact on operating sites in the Region.

I recognize that REP resources are limited, but it would be very helpful to me if you could arrange to have an individual assigned to work directly for me, who is very knowledgeable about all aspects of the Padiological Emergency Premaredness Program.

I appreciate your help with this situation created by the unusual confluence of requirements for many nuclear power plants in FEMA Region I. If I can answer any questions, please feel free to contact me at PTS 223-9540. I would be happy to discuss this with you at any time.
