Thank you for your letter dated July 3, 1986, informing us of the steps you have taken to correct the noncompliances which we brought to your attention in our letter dated June 6, 1986.

The actions you have taken appear to be appropriate; however, the following items were not addressed:

1. Has the training conducted in response to violations 373/86015-01A and 373/86015-01B been incorporated into the permanent operator training program? If not, when will this be accomplished?
2. Was the summary of licensed operator responsibilities prepared by the NSO incorporated into the permanent operator training program? If not, how will this summary be made available to operators licensed in the future?
3. In light of the significant number of wrong unit errors at LaSalle since Unit 2 licensing, what effort did the Commonwealth Edison Company make to assure itself that this error was an isolated event and that there are no other improperly hung tags currently in the field?
4. How will the effectiveness of your corrective actions, especially those initiated to prevent wrong unit errors, be assessed?

Please respond to these questions within 20 days of the receipt of this letter.
