Submittal of Additional Information

Portland General Electric (PGE) letter VPN-015-99, dated January 26, 1999, committed to provide additional information supporting the application for the Trojan ISFSI license. These items of information are listed below. Each of the items was to be submitted by February 12, 1999, with the exception of item 2, which was to be submitted by March 4, 1999. As indicated, items 1 and 6 were submitted earlier and item 2 will be submitted by the original commitment date. This letter provides items 3, 4, and 5.

5. An update to the ISFSI SAR to clarify that the Overpack is to be used for Interim Storage until an analysis conforming to the SRP criteria is performed, submitted, and approved. Enclosure 1 to this letter.
6. A request for an exemption from 10 CFR 72.70 that requires the final SAR submittal at least 90 days prior to fuel loading. Submitted via VPN-016-99 dated 2/9/99.


