## Submittal of Additional Information

Portland General Electric (PGE) letter VPN-015-99, dated January 26, 1999, committed to provide additional information supporting the application for the Trojan ISFSI license. These items of information are listed below. Each of the items was to be submitted by February 12, 1999, with the exception of item 2, which was to be submitted by March 4, 1999. As indicated, items 1 and 6 were submitted earlier and item 2 will be submitted by the original commitment date. This letter provides items 3, 4, and 5.

1. An update to the ISFSI Emergency Plan, PGE-1075.

Results of the load test of the PWR Basket structural lid hoist rings (testing completed by 2/25/99). Due 3/4/99.

 A request for an exemption from 10 CFR 72.70 that requires the final SAR submittal at least 90 days prior to fuel loading.

Enclosure 3 contains revised calculation PGE01-10.02.03-06, "TranStor™ Concrete Cask Tornado, Flood, Earthquake, and Explosion Analysis," which corrects a minor discrepancy in the Concrete Cask tipover analysis in support of the related changes to the SAR in Enclosure 1.
