
RE: Shipment Discrepancies

On February 22, 1999, three shipments of 11e.(2) waste from Generator 4005, waste stream 01, arrived at the Envirocare of Utah, Inc., (Envirocare) site without the necessary paperwork. The shipments were placed on hold and remained outside the restricted area until Envirocare had received the paperwork. Envirocare has informed the Generator that a corrective action plan that defines how they intend to prevent this type of incident in the future is required.
