Dear Joy:

In response to your July 17 request for additional information we offer the following:

- 1. Personal Monitoring Equipment
  - We have set up a program with Morrison-Knudsen Co., Inc., Safety and Environmental Services of Boise, Idaho, to supply us with thermoluminescent dosimeters (TLDs). The TLDs will be changed every three months.
- 2. Safety Procedures For Transporting Gauges or Devices We will follow all Department of Transportation regulations applicable to the packaging, labeling and transportation of the device. See attached letter to the DOT asking for a copy of the applicable regulations.
- 3. Operating and Emergency Procedures

All personnel have been provided with a disc describing in detail the following items:

- A. Use of personnel monitoring.
- B. Use of the device.
- C. Storage of the device.
- D. Transportation of the device.
- E. Leak testing.
- F. Emergency procedures.


