Based upon the enclosed information, New Hampshire Yankee respectfully requests that the closure of SER Confirmatory Issue No. 41 be reflected in the next supplement to the Seabrook Station SER and that Facility Operating License, NPF-56, be amended to remove Item 2.C.9 as a license condition.
