Regarding our license no. 34-24346-01 for the possession and use of radioactive material and devices for industrial radiography, I would like to reiterate our situation:

(1) On August 25, 1986, our Radiation Safety Officer terminated employment with Abex.

- (2) Since that time, the radioactive materials have been kept in the designated storage areas, all keys have been collected and are in my possession, and all control cables have been removed from the area.
- (3) We will not use these materials or acquire new materials until we receive approval from the MRC for a new radiation safety officer.
- (4) We hereby apply for an ammendment to our license to limit our possession of the regulated materials for the purpose of storage only. The materials shall be stored in the storage area designated in our license, and I shall be responsible for the security of the materials and devices.

For the ammendment detailed in item 4, I have enclosed a check for \$230.00.
