Decommissioning Plan submitted on November 19, 1998

SUMMARY:

I spoke with Mike Styvaert of Rock Island, Illinois. He works in the group of the Army that handles decommissioning contracts for all of the Army. He stated that a contract would be going out soon for bid on decommissioning work at Building 611B at Picatinny. They will not use the original contractor GPI. He stated that the Army currently wants to make all decom. plans in accordance with MARSSIM. He said that perhaps the NRC should not yet review the decom plan they submitted in accordance with 5849 since they would like to resubmit a decom. plan in accordance with MARSSIM as soon as they get the contract. He expects that the contracting and plan could be submitted by August 1999.

I spoke with Richard Fliszar of Picatinny and he stated that he does not have a problem with submitting in accordance with MARSSIM with one exception. He needs to check into the building integrity of Building 611B to see if it can be stabilized until Aug 1999. If the building cannot be reinforced until then, then the Army would like to begin decommissioning earlier so that more contamination does not get outside of the building. He will get back to me NLT March 5, 1999 to give an update.


ACTION:

If Picatinny Arsenal will submit a plan in accordance with MARSSIM (due to contractual arrangements), then the licensing action will be sent back and voided. They will then resubmit a plan at a later time.

If Building 611B cannot be reinforced, then we will have to have more discussions regarding their submittal of a plan in accordance with 5849 instead of MARSSIM. They may need to justify why they are not using MARSSIM.

Dear Mr. Kinneman,

Enclosed for your review is a copy of the complete version of the Decommissioning Plan for Building (Bldg.) 611B and the Radio Luminescent Source (RLS) Laboratory in Bldg. 18. Decommissioning/remediation for Bldg. 611B is presently planned for the Spring of 1999. However, weather permitting, we would like to decommission/remediate the Bldg. 18 RLS lab as soon as possible due to a leaking roof problem where the exhaust blower/stack system for the RLS lab may be a contributing factor.

Although it is understood that maintenance repair work of this nature could be performed in-house under a radiation work permit issued by this office, the problem for implementation is funding related. Money for decommissioning the RLS laboratory has already been appropriated through the Industrial Operations Command at Rock Island, Illinois, whereas the maintenance/repair alternative of in-house funding is more difficult to obtain at this time. It is, therefore, requested that your Agency at least assess the decommissioning plan for the Bldg. 18, RLS lab by January 15, 1999 so that decommissioning may begin and the leaking roof problem resolved.
