This refers to the emergency preparedness exercise inspection conducted by Mr. James Foster and others of this office on January 12-15, 1987, of activities at the Clinton Power Station, Unit 1, authorized by NRC Operating License NPF-55, and to the discussion of our findings with Mr. Hall and others of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.
