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
Subject: J. M. Farley Nuclear Plant NPDES Permit

Alabama Power Company's letter dated November 10, 1986 reported approval from the Alabama Department of Environmental Management (ADEM) for Farley Nuclear Plant to conduct a temporary chlorination program for Corbicula control in the service water system. This program consists of both a short term (three week) and long term evaluation period. The attached letter is confirmation of ADEM's approval to extend the short term evaluation period.


